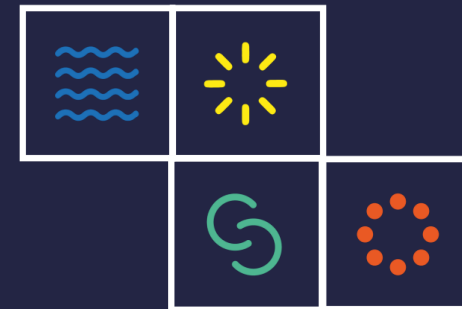

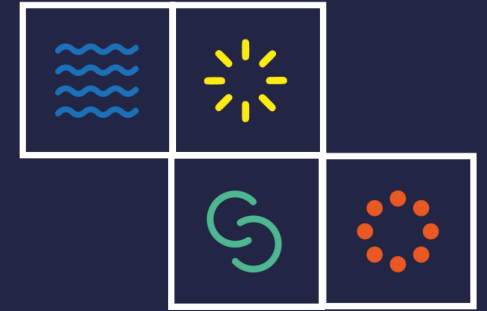

Organisation at national, regional, and local level that provides a range of services to energy communities in order to help them overcome barriers in the process of setting up their organization and/or projects at different stages of the process.

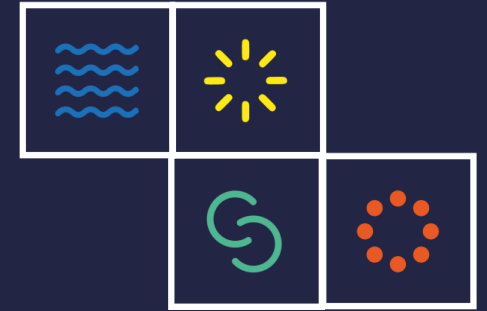
